Games will consist of two 20 minute halves with a 5 minute half time.

Scoring for pool play will be as follows:

4 points - win by 2 or more goals
3 points - win by 1 goal
2 points - tie with goals
1 point – tie with no goals
0 points - loss

In the event of a tie at the end of pool play, the following criteria will be used to determine final standings:

- head to head result (who beat who), if the teams are still tied
- Goals difference, calculated by subtracting goals conceded from goals scored. If teams are still tied
- Goals for, if teams are still tied
- 8 second penalty shoot out will take place after the last pool game

Water-based turf - Running shoes or turf boots only please. No food, drink, gum or dogs are allowed on the fields.

Warm-up - There will only be ***5 minutes in between games*** so please warm-up on the rubber-turf field and be ready to go onto the water-based turf directly at your scheduled game time. Your cooperation in this matter will help everything run smoothly and avoid losing light due to delays.

Umpires – we will do our best to make sure there is an umpire for each game; however, in the event that we are short on umpires please be prepared to umpire games that are directly after your game.

Athletic Therapist – an athletic therapist will be on site for pre-game taping (please provide your own team tape) and first aid in the event of an injury.
